Note: To ensure public confidence, a Canvassing Board Majority should always be present for all election processes.

All meetings shall be conducted at the Bay County Election Center, 205 Mosley Drive, Lynn Haven, FL.

April 30th - Thursday

- Initial absentee ballot mailing and thereafter daily.

May 4th – Monday (F.S. 102.141 & 286.011)

(Board Majority Required)

- 8:00 a.m. - Canvassing Board Orientation Meeting
- 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. – Canvassing Board officially convenes for public testing and shall include all aspects of the Municipal Election. The Canvassing Board Members may designate a representative for testing per F.S. 101.5612(2) & F.S. 101.657.

May 5th – Tuesday (ONLY if Required)

- 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. - Resume testing of all Voting Equipment until complete

May 11th – May 15th (Monday through Friday)

(Canvassing Board Members must be on call)

- Early Voting - 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.

May 18th – Monday (F.S.101.68)

(Board Majority Required)

- 8:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. - Begin canvassing of Absentee Ballots

(No Decisions Required; No Canvassing Board Meeting)

- 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. - As directed, SOE staff researches any Provisional Ballots

May 22nd – Friday

- 8:30 a.m. - Reconvene to provide decisions on any Provisional Ballots
- 9:00 a.m. - Final approval; Official Results **(Only if recount is not required)**
 - Complete Conduct of Election Report **(Only if recount is not required)**

May 22nd – Friday (F.S.102.141(6) & 102.166 Rule 1S-2.027) RECOUNT Municipalities ONLY

(Board Majority Required)

- 9:30 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. - Reconvene to begin recount **(if recount is required)**

 - 10:00 a.m. - Conduct Recount for Official Results
 - Upon Completion of Official Results, Board adjourns from Election
